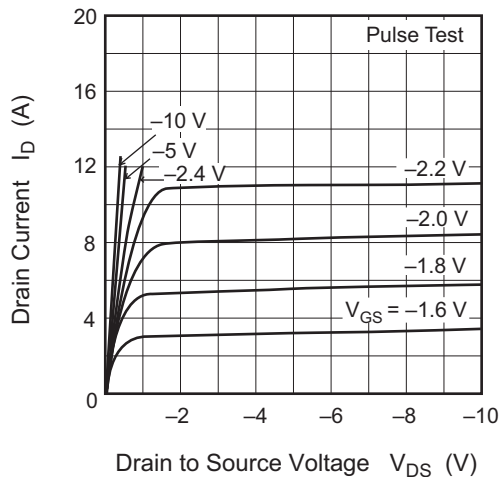
Power vs. Temperature Derating



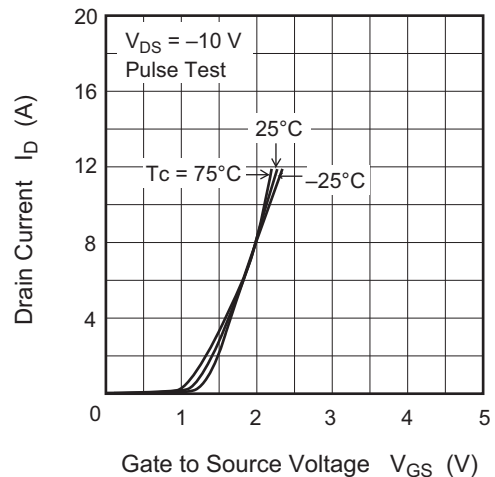
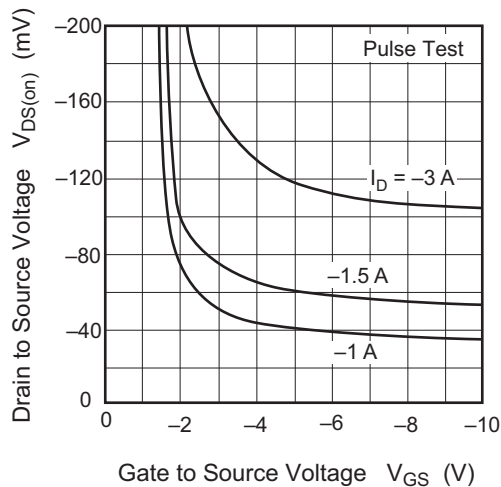
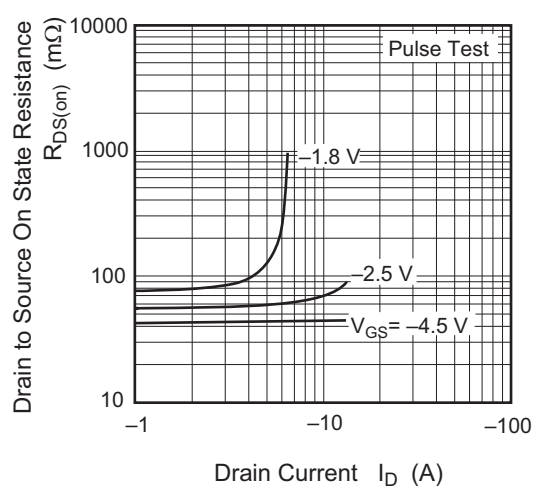

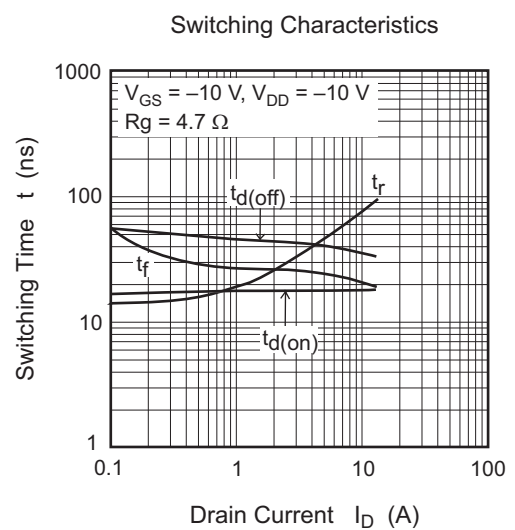
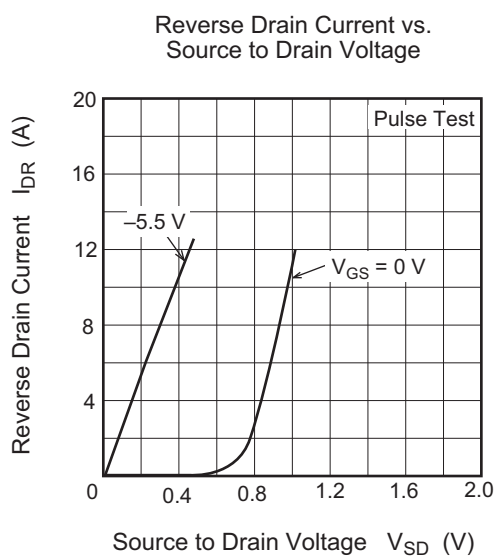
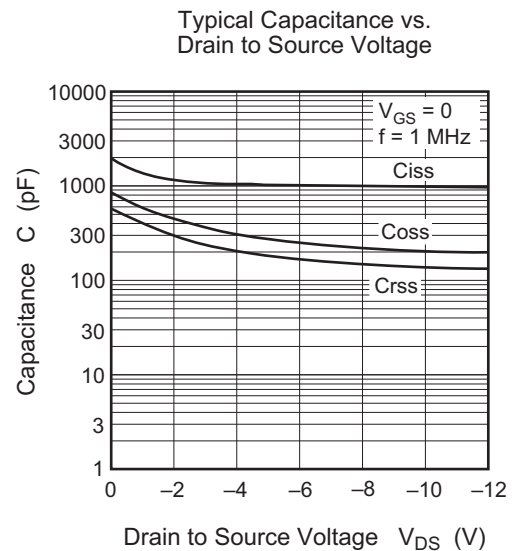
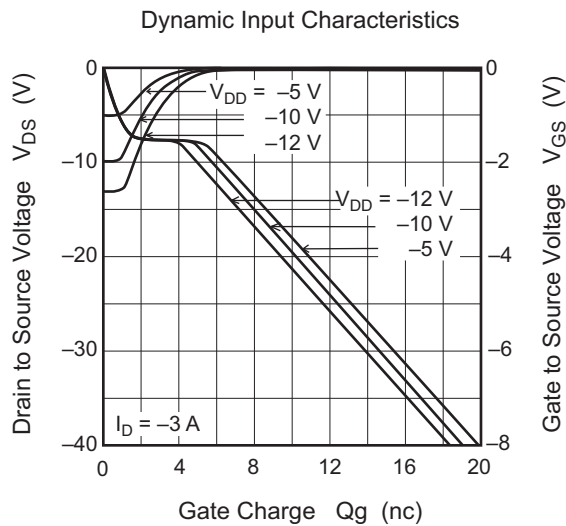
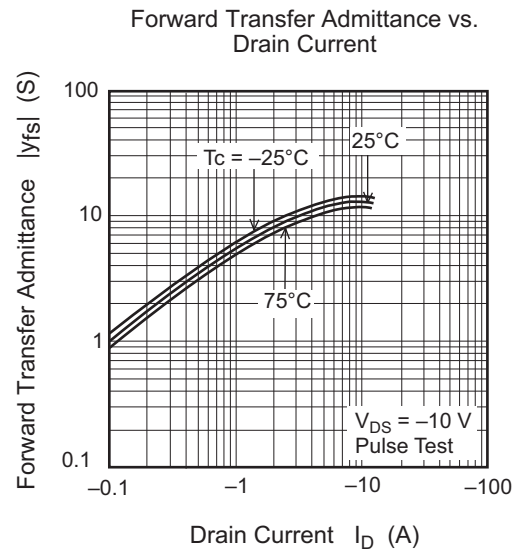
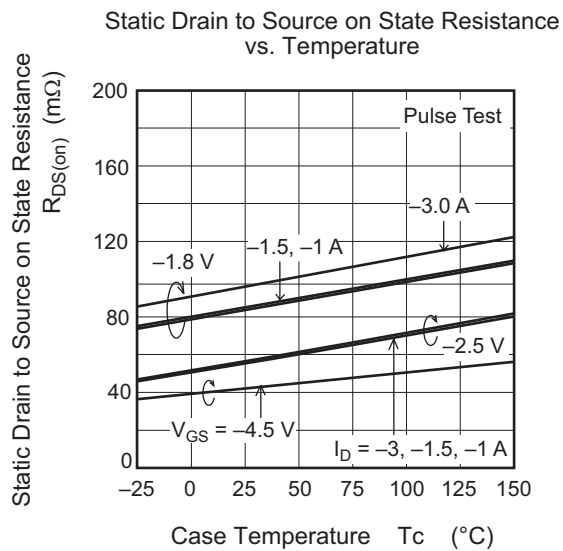


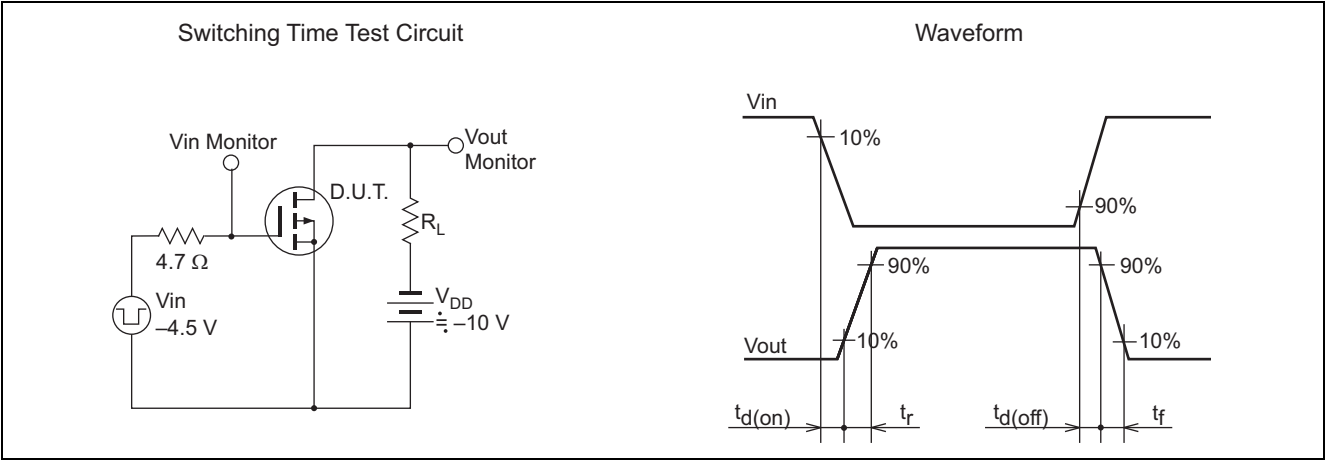
Typical Output Characteristics



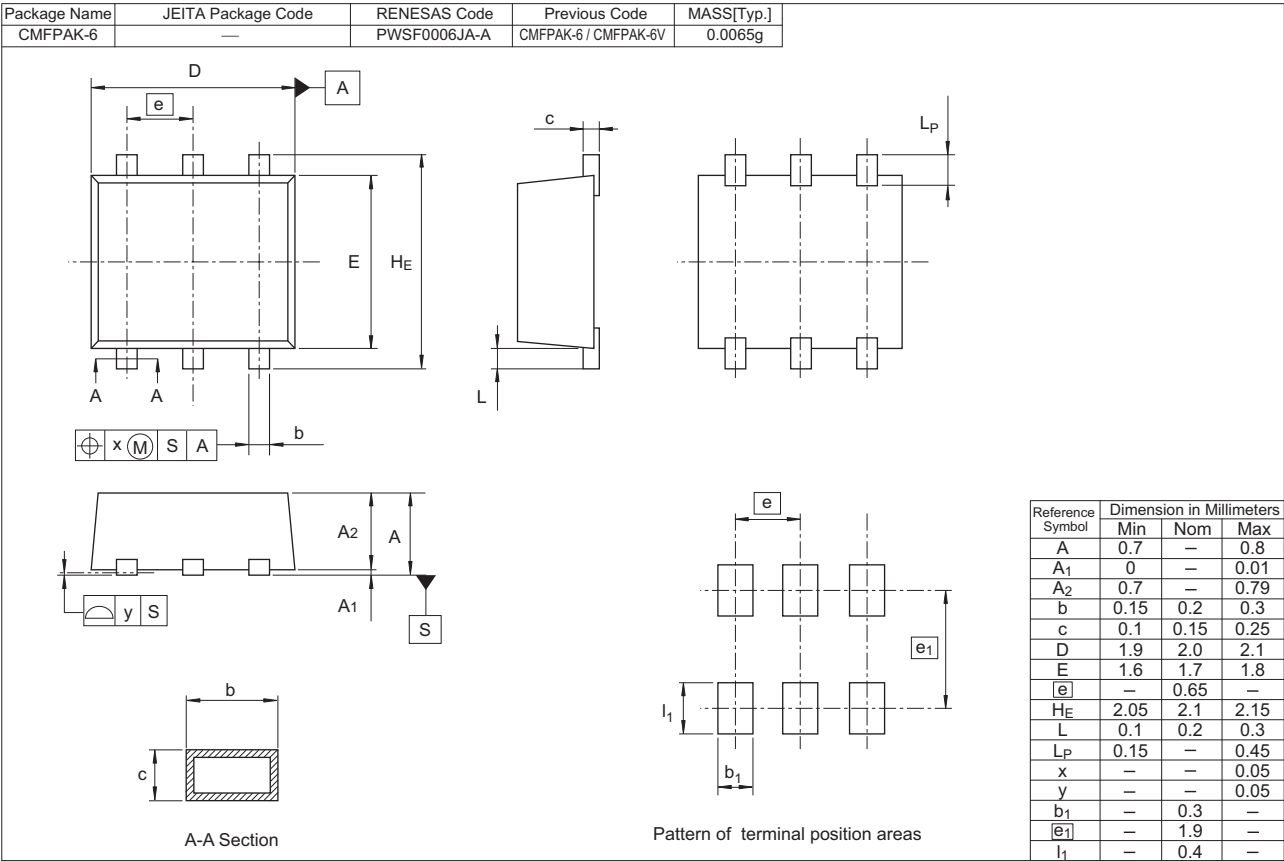
Typical Transfer Characteristics
